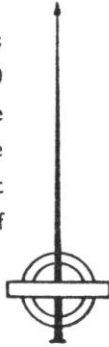


Greetings

FROM LONDON TRANSPORT

on the occasion of the Visit to the U.S.A. of three London Transport Buses, March-July, 1952.

London Transport's fleet of road vehicles and electric trains serves a population of 10 million people in an area of over 2,000 square miles. More than 12½ million passengers are carried every day. Frequent and convenient services are provided to every point of interest within 30 miles of the centre of London.



Your visit to London will be easier and more comfortable if you buy 'Go As You Please' tickets beforehand. These tickets cover 7 days unlimited travel on all London Transport services (except Green Line Coaches). They cost \$3.50 each from your Travel Agent or any British Railways Office, and can only be purchased in North America.
