Back in the earliest days of Redhill Road, Cobham one of our earliest residents was Inter-Station Cub C III owned then by Alan Cross and David Hurley.

In recent years the bus has been owned by Des Maybury, and after an extensive restoration by Sebastian Marshall and the team at Historic Vehicle Restorations it will be launched on the HCVS annual London-Brighton run on 7th May.

One week before this it has been arranged to take the bus out at night and photograph it at certain main line railway stations. Noted photographer Peter Zabek will not only provide the photographic expertise but also period costumed actors. This will produce a beautiful set of 'period' photographs.

Thanks to the generosity of the owner, we are able to offer a very limited number of places to members on this unique occasion. Members will be collected at a prearranged location in West London at around 2300 on 1st May and taken to the various venues by LBM vehicle where they will find the Inter-Station Cub parked. Opportunities to actually ride in the Cub between locations will also take place. The actual itinerary will remain confidential (to prevent 'guerilla' opportunities!) but guests will be conveyed to each of them during the night. The locations are generally central London main-line railway stations served by the Inter-Station service, and chosen to avoid as much modern impedimenta as possible.

Guests are welcome to take their own photographs but we will be asking that they refrain from posting on social media for a couple of days until the 'official' ones are ready.

We would expect to be completed by 0400 and guests can be dropped at suitable locations on or near the A3 corridor as the bus returns to Brooklands. A start and finish and at Brooklands is also available.

Tickets are £100 each and are available on a 'first-come, first-served' basis. Proceeds of course come to London Bus Museum.
